

FORK POM POM MOBILE

TIME: APPROX 1 HOUR

MATERIALS:

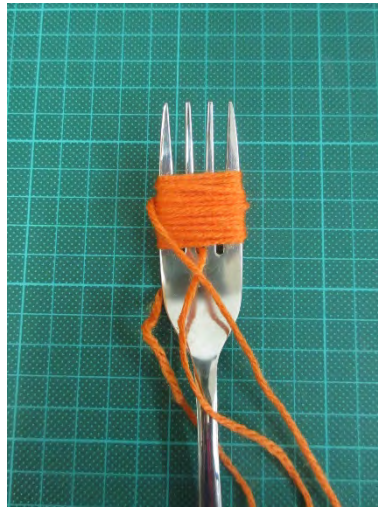
- A FORK
- 10 MTRS OF WOOL
- SCISSORS
- STRONG TWIG APPROX 25CM WIDE

1. Slot 1 metre of wool evenly between the centre prongs of the fork.



2. Wind 3 – 4 metre of wool evenly around the prongs of the fork.



3. Tie 1 metre of wool around the wound wool and knot securely.



4. Slide the wool carefully off the fork.



5. Carefully cut through the loops of wound wool to form the pom pom.



6. Trim the pom pom as required to create an even round ball.



7. Arrange all pom poms at required heights from the twig.



8. Tie pom poms on to the twig.



9. Trim excess wool after knotting.



10. Wind wool around the twig and tie a length of wool to create hanger.
